The Letterforms are based on the original drawings of Felice Feliciano, circa 1460, reproduced by Jason Dewinetz and printed in 20 colours from over 90 polymer plates on a Vandercook press. The paper is Magnani Biblos, milled in Italy, and the cover and endsheets were handmade by Reg Lissel in Vancouver. The text types are ATF Cloister Old Style and Monotype Cloister Italic, with the Monotype sorts cast by Jim Rimmer in New Westminster, B.C. Produced in an edition of 115 copies: 100 numbered copies for sale and 15 for private distribution. s7/8 by 73/4 inches, 80pp. \$300.

Greenboathouse Press is a small publishing concern based in Vernon, B.C., producing short-run limited editions, printed letterpress and bound by hand. Their mandate is to publish work that is compelling both in its content and its form, with attention to typography, design and fine printing.

The Letterpress Gazette is a quarterly collaborative work that endeavours to preserve and promote the art of printing through a collection of articles, poetry, printing tips and event listings submitted by the members. The gazette is letterpress printed at the Weathervane Press on a Vandercook SP15. Each issue is printed double-sided on 11" by 17" fine paper using an array of typefaces and devices. Issue editions range from 50 to 70 and often contain additional keepsakes. \$10 each, \$30 annual subscription (4 issues, includes postage).

The Ottawa Press Gang is a collective of printers from the Ottawa Valley that first met in 2004. The members regularly produce books, pamphlets, posters, broadsides and other ephemera individually and also contribute to various group projects undertaken each year.
