Barbarian Press of Mission, B.C., has designed *The Play of Pericles* as a tall quarto and printed on Zerkall paper in several colours. The typefaces used are Poliphilus and Blado, with Duensing for display. The text will be illustrated with over 80 wood engravings and accented with printed calligraphy specially designed by Andrea Taylor. The play will be accompanied by a second volume comprising a substantial essay on the play's history and a discussion of the various theories about its composition and Shakespeare's possible collaborator, together with a glossary and notes on the text.

The standard edition (125 copies) is issued in full purple morocco. The accompanying volume of essays and notes will be in quarter morocco with printed paper designed by Andrea Taylor, in a chemise and slipcase. The set is priced at \$2,250.

A deluxe edition (12 copies) will be bound by Hélène Francoeur in alum-tawed goat with purple morocco onlays stamped in gold; supplementary volume in quarter alum-tawed goat with paper printed with calligraphy by Andrea Taylor. Accompanied by a portfolio of signed and numbered proofs of engravings, the whole contained in a box of purple cloth with a vellum label stamped in gold. The deluxe set is priced at \$3,500.
