## Upcoming Shows & Events

### Sat November 24th 2007 - Book Launch

Reflections on the C-Word—At the centre of the cancer labyrinth *by Carol Matthews, I Illustrated by gallery artist Jenny Waelti-Walters*. Published by Hedgerow Press. The artist and publisher will be present.

### December 2007 - The Letterpress Show

This show will introduce the fine publications of Heavenly Monkey and other regional fine presses. We will be featuring a Heavenly Monkey edition, *The Temperamental Rose & Other Ways of Seeing Colour*. This is a collaboration between author and book designer Barbara Hodgson, and bookbinder Claudia Cohen. Also featured will be the Heavenly Monkey, *Iskandariya*. This is a collaboration with artist Briony Morrow-Cribbs, who is developing (& printing) a series of 11 aquatint prints to accompany the first book publication of Brigit Pegeen Kelly's prose poem *Iskandariya*. Some limited and open edition broadsides will be available by Heavenly Monkey and other letterpress printers.

### February 2008 - Twenty One Years - Twenty One Prints The Etchings of Charles van Sandwyk

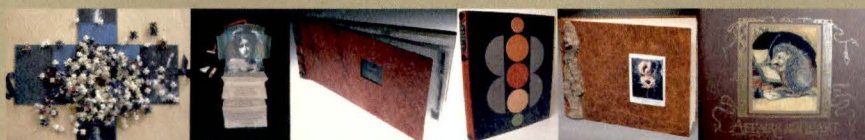
We will be introducing Charles's Magnum Opus, *Twenty One Years - Twenty one prints*. This is a Ltd (10) edition, leather bound and hand tooled volume, with an accompanying clamshell box by Seattle bookbinder Claudia Cohen. It includes an essay and over 60 original sepia etchings. Original etchings and other illustrated books by van Sandwyk will also be available. The artist will be in attendance, schedule permitting.

### March 2008 - Book Arts Showcase II - 'Flight'

This is a juried exhibition of artists' books & fine bindings by contemporary Canadian bookbinders and book artists. Participants are asked to explore the theme of 'Flight', in all its various interpretations. A limited edition catalog will be issued.

### April 2008 - Books2Eat - The International Edible Book Festival

Due to the incredible response in 2007, Arts on Atlantic Gallery will be partnering with St Mary's University College to stage the 2008 festival of edible art know as Books2Eat. The event will be held at the college. The 2008 theme is *The Wizard of Oz*.
