She returned to the Castlegar campus in 1984 and, in addition to Cataloguing, took on other duties in the areas of Reference and Information Literacy Instruction. Judy also served as Library Department Head from 2005 to 2008.

During her 33-year tenure, Judy helped implement the library's automation system, served as chair of BCCATS, was a recipient of a SCOPE teaching award and volunteered as secretary of the faculty union.

And I will certainly miss the wonderful people in the library and all the great college staff and students I have worked with over the years."
