Founded in the 1990's under the name of the Third World Libraries Interest Group (TWLIG) the group became Libraries Across Borders (LAB) in 2000. Membership is comprised mainly of library personnel. However, LAB is open for anyone to join. LAB's mission is to support through the Assistance to Libraries Fund (ALF) indigenous and international community-based library initiatives. This is done with the generous

support of individual and monthly donors. LAB's most recent donation of \$3,000.00 went to Busolwe Public Library in Uganda. As of December 31, 2012, LAB has \$14,804.68 in both the ALF and LAB accounts. Future LAB goals will be to reconnect with previous partners, develop new partnerships, and provide a forum for international librarianship.
